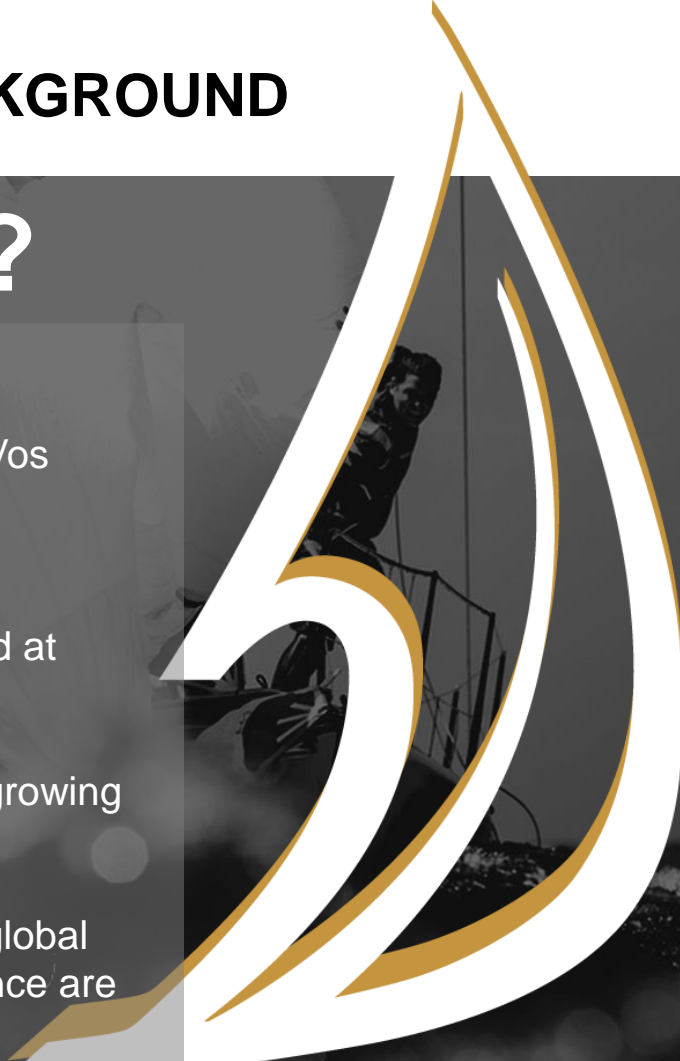

METRES & SECONDS = HIGH VALUE



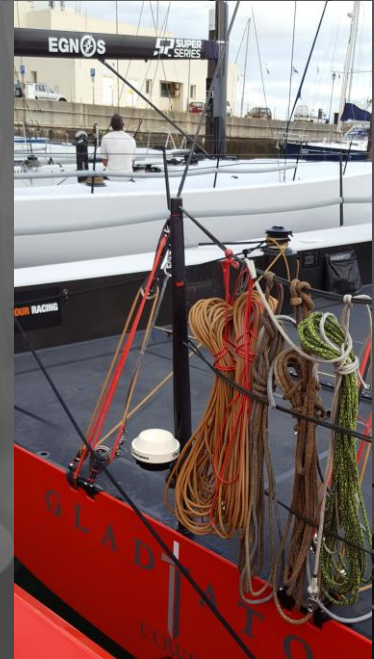
3. THE START LINE

- An imaginary start line is set between a flag and a committee boat.
- All boats position themselves at the start line before the start time.
- The committee will raise a flag 5 mins and 1 minute before the start.
- Timing and precision is key as when the race commences if one boat is $5 \cdot 10^{-4}$ seconds over the start line then an individual flag is raised and that boat will have to circle and cross the start line again.



4. ONBOARD EQUIPMENT

- Each TP52 boat is equipped with receptors from Garmin and Hemisphere to capture the EGNOS signal.
- This is imperative and can mean the make or break to winning the race.
- Accuracy is key.
